

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT

- C+ On the competition day, the participating schools will conduct the contest at their respective **venues**
- C+ Schools are responsible for complying the regulations of the competition
- C+ All participant should sit for the competition at once. However, the Teacher-In-Charge could arrange for participants to answer the question in batches should there be any hindrance
- C+ If a participant is disconnected during the competition, they are allowed to resume once the internet connection is restored, but lost time will be counted towards the 75-minute time limit. Therefore, it is important to ensure that the internet connection is stable before starting the competition

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- C+Registration for the competition is done by the Teacher-In-Charge at www.contesthub.my/register
- C+ Fill in the school, teacher and student detail and make the payment
- C+The Competition manual, username and password for participants will be provided in the Contesthub a few days before the competition day
- C+During the competition period, schools conduct the competition at their venues and invigilated by the Teacher-In-Charge
- C+Schools enforce the standard examination or competition regulations
- C+Result will be announced in September 2023
- C+ The e-certificate will be provided in the Contesthub
- GHard copies of the certificates and medals for winners will be couriered to the schools
